Trimble® PG200: Firmware Version 5.08 Release Notes and **Update Instructions**

These release notes provide important information about the firmware for the Trimble® PG200. Please read these release notes carefully.

CAUTION – This process re-installs the device firmware, and resets Bluetooth on your PG200. You will need to re-pair the PG200 to your mobile device after the install process has completed. Do NOT unplug the PG200 USB cable until after the firmware install has completed.

Installing the PG200 firmware

- 1. Ensure the PG200 is turned off
- 2. Connect the PG200 to the PC using the USB cable
- 3. Open the Firmware Update Wizard; Firmware version 5.08.exe
- 4. Click Yes
- 5. Select the unit from the drop down list (it should be auto-detected)
- 6. Click Next
- 7. The application will replace the firmware on the device with the new image. This will take approximately 5 minutes, during which time the progress bar will move and at times the lights on the unit will flash
- 8. Once the process has finished click Finish to close the Firmware Update Wizard
